I support the current self-insurer licensing framework. I support the current regulatory monitoring of Self-Insurers, in particular NAT auditing by the Regulator. Regarding NAT audit frequencies, I support the current 3 year audit frequency for those Self-Insurers that meet the benchmarks and annual audits for Self-Insurers that don't meet the benchmarks as to change this would potentially compromise workplace safety. I've been working in safety for over 40 years and believe that external auditing is essential for workplace safety. It would be impossible for the Regulator to audit all NSW employers but audits of Self-Insurers provides a reasonably practicable way for a sample of workplaces to be audited.

Self regulations does NOT work. The only way to ensure and maintain a safe workplace is to apply external audits to ensure compliance.
